## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Action aims at strengthening the role and the capacity of 24 Libyan Municipalities located along key migration routes towards the provision of basic services and facilities to improve the living standards of the most vulnerable segments of the population, including migrants, IDPs and refugees.

The Action is carried out in close coordination with the 24 Municipalities as fundamental actors in the process of pacification and stabilization of the Country as well as the national Authorities including the Ministry of Local Governance, Ministry of Planning and relevant line Ministries.

# **SECTORS OF INTERVENTION**

Complementing ongoing stabilization efforts, AICS intervenes in 3 macro-sectors:

- Health: facilities rehabilitation and supply of equipment to hospitals, clinics and dispensaries; training to staff and awareness campaigns;
- Education: kindergartens, primary and secondary schools, vocational training centres, higher education centres will be improved and equipped, teachers and staff trained and curricula improved through seminars, lectures and workshop;
- Water, sanitation and hygiene: rehabilitation of urban schemes such as storage tanks and distribution systems.

# WHAT AICS DOES

In a scenario of deep institutional fragmentation and lack of human and financial resources, the Italian intervention focuses on:

- Direct Capacity Building & Technical Assistance to Municipalities;
