

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2nd Call for Proposals HEALTH SECTOR



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To rehabilitate - and build capacity to operate - health service facilities

Overall indicative amount: EUR 1,490,000

- Upgrading of health service facilities through rehabilitation and maintenance of hospitals, health centers, etc.
- Provision of equipment for the improvement of health service provision
- *Capacity building* of the staff involved in the management and operation of the target facilities
- Local community awareness activities and local consultation and feedback mechanisms on inclusive access to health services (including for IDPs, migrants and asylum seekers), including conflict-sensitive messaging and communication modalities

Zawiya Teaching Hospital (ZTH)

Provision of equipment for the gynecology and pediatric departments

Minimum amount: EUR 420,000 - Maximum amount EUR 490,000





PARTNERSHIP:

- Partnerships among international NGOs and with local partners are highly valued
- Given the narrow focus of the Call, <u>small number of partners</u> is preferable to simplify grant management & contain costs

NEEDS ASSESSMENT:

- Relatively simple interventions Technical reconnaissance led to narrowed down list
- Municipalities are clear on what they can expect from these interventions: indicative list of medical equipment and technical standards defined
- Municipalities technical departments ready to facilitate further needs assessments carried out by INGO partners







PRE-FINANCING GUARANTEE

AICS requirement:

 ✓ 30% of first instalment released at contract completion

<u>N.B.</u> Bank guarantee costs eligible as direct costs

INSTALMENTS

- Determined under grant contract
- According to PRAG General Conditions depending on contract duration:
 - ✓up to 12 months
 - ✓ beyond 12 months
- To be specified in the Special Conditions
