The present Q&A 2nd Round of Publication complements the previous Q&A published on 20 Dec. 2019, as potential applicants submitted additional questions and requests for clarifications. Answers are provided for the benefit of all interested applicants, as indicated in the Guidelines for grant applicants of this Call for Proposals and in line with PRAG stipulations.

Question	Answer
Q1: Can applicants submit proposals just for a single Lot included in the Call?	A4: Yes. Applicants are expected to decide which Lot(s) of the Call they wish to apply for.
Q2: Recent events may cause access limitations to conduct assessments in specific locations. How can applicants deal with such situations?	As already pointed out in the Q&A 1 st Round, each proposal is expected to cover interventions in all the municipalities listed under each lot, within the defined maximum budget (ref. Guidelines for grant applicants, section 1.3 <i>Financial allocation provided by the Contracting Authority</i>). In the proposals, INGO partners may contribute their own local knowledge to complement available information. Considering the need for flexibility, possible adjustments may be proposed and negotiated according to the provisions of the General Conditions – e.g. stemming from in-depth technical assessments conducted in close consultation with the Municipality authorities during the inception phase.
