1. Improving the use of water resources in Libya (1,825 M EUR) – Lot 1

Specific Objective 1: Improve the management and equitable access to safe drinking water supplies and adequate sanitation services.

Specific Objective 2: Increase water efficiency in the agricultural sector and reduce the number of people suffering from water scarcity and food insecurity.

Result 1: Improved access to equitable and safe drinking water supply.

Result 2: Improved access to adequate sanitation and hygiene services.


Result 3: Strengthened capacities of local authorities on water governance.

2. Clean energy for a sustainable access to basic services (2,025 M EUR) – Lot 2

General Objective: Improve the living conditions of the Libyan population

Specific Objective: Facilitate access to basic services for the Libyan population

Result 1: Increased energy supply in facilities providing basic services.


Result 2: Strengthened technical skills in energy-related areas.

Result 3: Improved local capacities in the delivery of health and educational services.

Geographic Target: East (Sahil Al Jebel; Ijikharra; Beida), West (Nesma; Baten Al Jabal; Zawiya South), South (Wadi Otba; Barka; Tajarhi).

Main details

Budget:

- Lot 1:
 - 912.500,00 euro for projects submitted by a single NGO;
 - 1.825.000,00 euro for projects submitted by two or more NGOs.
- Lot 2:
 - 1.012.500,00 euro for projects submitted by a single NGO;
 - 2.025.000,00 euro for projects submitted by two or more NGOs.

Maximum duration: 18 months.

Each NGO/consortium can submit a project proposal for each Lot.



Next steps

- □ AICS published an open *Call for Proposals* on January 31st, 2025. Only NGOs that are duly registered in Italy and in Libya can apply.
- ☐ The current deadline for applying is April 15th, 2025 at 14.00 (Tunisian time GMT + 1)
- ☐ Applicant NGOs can submit questions until February 21st
- ☐ AICS will publish official FAQs on February 28th



Timeline for the selection of NGOs

The process started with the publication of the Call for Proposals on January 31st, 2025.

1 Submission of Project Proposals (NGOs)

15April 2025 2 Selection of Proposals (AICS)

15 May 2025 3 Preparation of admin. docs (AICS/ selected NGOs)

15 July 2025

The selection process ends with the signature of the Contract between AICS and the selected NGOs (official start of activities).



Coordination Mechanism with the MoLG

- 1. Applicant NGOs must obtain a Letter of authorization by the MoLG to start the needs assessment in the target municipalities.
- 2. After completing the assessment, NGOs must request that the Mayors of the target municipalities send a letter to the MoLG listing the agreed activities. To expedite the process, NGOs can share a copy of the letter with the MoLG themselves;
- 3. Following this, the MoLG will issue a letter of support for each applicant NGO/Consortium based on the Mayors' letters. Each applicant NGO/Consortium must attach this letter to their proposal to be submitted to AICS.
